## ALLIE HARRISON POSING HER HEN "THE CHICKEN WHISPERER"



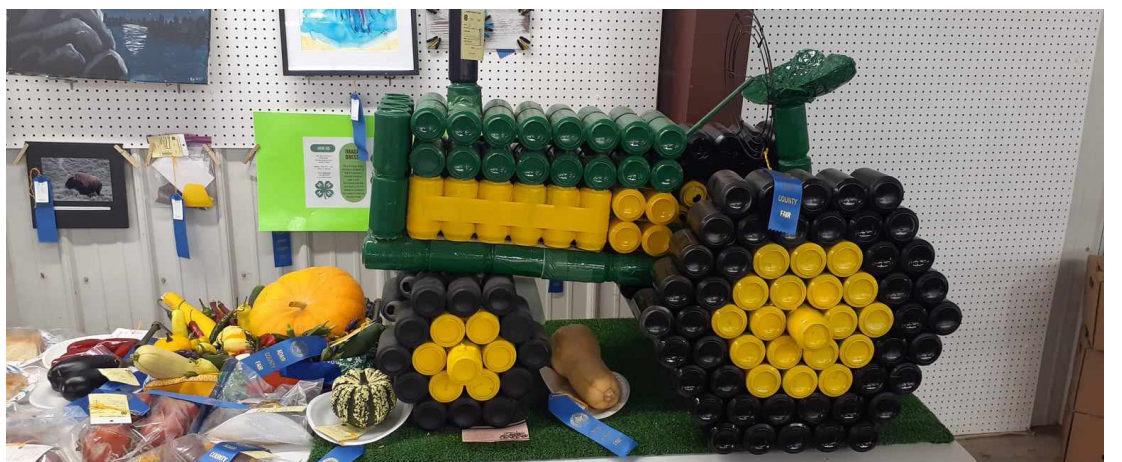

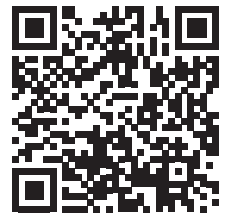
