Books were really heavy in those days. Checking one out probably required at least 4 strong men. With the advent of papyrus parchment, things lightened up considerably. As a source of information, the Library proved to be indispensable and thus, became the hub of education. Today's Library has moved on with new technology being at the forefront of its tramsformation from the old days. Stilwell Library has all the modern tools necessary to serve the needs of its patrons. On top of that, Stilwell Library has an exceptional Librarian. For one thing, she speaks fluent Spanish. Read on.

Stilwell Public Library: More Than Books

The word "library" comes from the Latin word "libra" which means "book." Yes. the library is a depository for books and the Stilwell Public Library certainly has its share of books stacked on the shelves waiting to be read. As part of the Eastern Oklahoma Library System (EOLS), one can find just about all the books that are currently in circulation. If it is not on the shelf, your librarian can order it through the system. On June 1, Rachele Horney celebrated her 2 year anniversary as Stilwell Public Library's Head Librarian. I had a chance to sit down with her and get her story. She tells about how she grew up in the Central Valley of California in a small town that eventually coalesced with 4 other small towns and became Santa Clarita. It was when her oldest child started kindergarten that Rachelle decided to volunteer at his school. Through the next several years her volunteering turned into a full time career where she became the school librarian. Along the way, she earned a Master's Degree in Library Science from San Jose State. It was after her son moved his family to Rogers, Arkansas that Rachele decided to search for a Library position that would

put her near her grandchildren. She found an opening at the Muskogee Public Library. With hardly anything more than a tootbrush, she made the move from California to Muskogee where she became Head Of Youth Services. With an eye on working even closer to Rogers, Rachele saw that Stilwell was looking for a Head Librarian. She got the job. Being brand new in a small town like Stilwell always presents the task of "breaking the ice" to form new relationships and becoming known. She hit the ground running. When I asked her what her primary goal for the Library is, she said, "I would like to see more people make use of all that the Library has to offer." The Stilwell Public Library offers much more than books. She said, "It is now possible to access all of the Libary's resources from the comfort of your home using your Library card and the Library's website." "Wow!" I said, "I did not know that?" It made me stop and think about how many others also do not know that. Rach-


