BREAKING NEWS: Lost City is no longer lost. The Roving Reporter, with his sidekick, Stephanie, recently found this obscure community. It was there alongside of the road all the time. More about this as you read this story.




Lost City, Oklahoma. Most have never heard of it. Some have. Lost City gets lost in the shuffle, but why, one might ask? One reason is that the town, such as it is, never really grew much. When and how did this town start and how did it get its intriguing name? One story tells of a band of Indians that set up an encampment along 14 mile creek around the turn of the 20th century. Then one day, without explanation and without a trace left behind, the people just flat out disappeared. Lost. It was because of that event that the new residents of that place took up the name "Lost City." That is one popular version of how this location got its name. The other version tells of a band of gypsies that had set up their gypsy camp at that place. Once again, mysteriously, the entire band disappeared without a trace. Even their campfires were still burning. Lost. What the truth is may never be found. Yet Lost City does have a history. There was a Kindergarten through 8th grade school there that got started clear back in 1902. Although the original building is gone, this school was in operation until 2008, when the Oklahoma Department of Education shut it down. The children were disbursed among schools at Hulbert, Peggs, Shady Grove and Tahlequah. That building remains and is used as a community center. From the accompanying photos, one can see that it is overgrown with weeds which gives it an abandoned look. The baseball field is in similar shape yet still has the light towers. Lost City did have a flickering flash of fame. It came

on January 3, 1970. The Prairie Meteorite Network photographed the track of a meteroid fireball. The track showed that the location of its descent might have fallen east of Lost City. A nearly 22 pound meteorite was found in a ditch about a half-mile from Lost City. The meteorite was taken to the school and shown to students. Someone from the Prairie Meteorite Network came looking for it. He found it in Lost City and took it to the Smithsonian Institute in Washington D.C. where, ostensibly, it is still there today. Lost City briefly found itself on the map! In a way, Lost City is still lost since there is no discernable evidence of a town: no post office, no stores, no school, no church.

Women's Bill of Rights

Whereas, males and females possess unique and immutable biological differences that manifest prior to birth and increase as they age and experience puberty;

Whereas, biological differences between the sexes mean that only females are able to get pregnant, give birth, and breastfeed children;

Whereas, biological differences between the sexes mean that males are, on average, bigger, stronger, and faster than females;

Whereas, biological differences between the sexes leave females more physically vulnerable than males to specific forms of violence, including sexual violence;

Whereas, females have historically suffered from discrimination in education, athletics, and employment;

Whereas, biological differences between the sexes are enduring and may, in some circumstances, warrant the creation of separate social, educational, athletic, or other spaces in order to ensure safety and/or to allow members of each sex to succeed and thrive;

Whereas, inconsistencies in court rulings and policy initiatives with respect to the definitions of 'sex,' 'male,' 'female,' 'man,' and 'woman' have led to endangerment of single-sex spaces and resources, thereby necessitating clarification of certain terms,

We affirm that:

For purposes of state/federal law, a person's 'sex' is defined as his or her biological sex (either male or female) at birth;

For purposes of state/federal law, a 'female' is an individual whose biological reproductive system is developed to produce ova; a 'male' is an individual whose biological reproductive system is developed to fertilize the ova of a female;

For purposes of state/federal law, 'woman' and 'girl' refer to human females, and the terms 'man' and 'boy' refer to human males;

For purposes of state/federal law, the word 'mother' is defined as a parent of the female sex and 'father' is defined as a parent of the male sex;

When it comes to sex, 'equal' does not mean 'same' or 'identical';

When it comes to sex, separate is not inherently unequal; There are legitimate reasons to distinguish between the sexes with respect to athletics, prisons or other detention facilities, domestic violence shelters, rape crisis centers, locker rooms, restrooms, and other areas where biology, safety, and/or privacy are implicated;

Policies and laws that distinguish between the sexes are subject to intermediate constitutional scrutiny, which forbids unfair discrimination against similarly-situated males and females but allows the law to distinguish between the sexes where such distinctions are substantially related to important governmental objectives;

Any public school or school district and any federal/ state/local agency, department, or office that collects vital statistics for the purpose of complying with anti-discrimination laws or for the purpose of gathering accurate

public health, crime, economic or other data shall identify each individual who is part of the collected data set as either male or female at birth.





VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE APPROACHES

18, August 2023, is the last day to apply for voter registration in order to be eligible to vote in the September 12 Kansas Public School (SD I00321) Special Proposition Election, Adair County Election Board Secretary Jan Wilhite said today.

Wilhite said that persons who are United States Citizens, residents of Oklahoma, and at least 17 ½ years old are eligible to apply for voter registration. However, you must be at least 18 years old to vote.

Applications must be received by the County Election Board or postmarked no later than midnight, August 18. Applications postmarked after that time will be accepted, but will not be processed until after the September 12 Election. Applications may also be submitted to any motor vehicle agency that is also an official voter registration agency by the submission deadline.

Applicants will be notified in writing when their application has been processed. Approved voters will receive a Voter Identification Card in the mail. Some may receive a letter that explains the reason or reasons the application was not approved. Wilhite said those who do not receive a response within 30 days of submitting their application should contact the County Election Board office immediately.

The Adair County Election Board reminds voters that applications must be approved by the County Election Board Secretary in order to vote.

Registered voters who have moved to Adair County from a different county or state will need to complete a new Voter Registration Application in order to be eligible for elections in Adair County. If you have moved within the county and need to update your address, you may make changes online using the OK Voter Portal at oklahoma.gov/elections/ovp or complete a Voter Registration Application.

Voter Registration Applications can be downloaded from the State Election Board website at oklahoma. gov/elections. You may also complete a form at your County Election Board. Most post offices, tag agencies, and public libraries have applications available upon request.

The Adair County Election Board is located at 220 W. Division and is open from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. For questions, please contact the Election Board at 918-696-7221 or Adaircounty@elections.ok.gov.


